1. Read Isaiah 55:8-9.

A. God's thoughts and ways are not the same as ours.

- We must read God's Word regularly to learn His thoughts and ways.
- We must let God's Word direct our decisions, relationships, and priorities, rather than relying on our thoughts and ways.

2. Read 2Timothy 3:14-17.

A. God's Word is able to make us wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.

• The Bible explains our need for salvation, God's salvation plan through Christ, and how to respond in faith.

B. All Scripture is breathed out by God.

• We must accept everything the Bible says as coming from God.

C. God's Word is useful for:

- Teaching: It helps us understand God's thoughts and follow His ways.
- Reproof: It exposes our sinful thoughts and ways.
- Correction: It corrects the way we think and live.
- Training in Righteousness: It trains us to live according to God's ways and thoughts.

D. God's Word equips us for every good work.

• It prepares us for every task God calls us to.

3. Read 2Peter 1:19-21

A. We must pay attention to God's Word.

We must take Scripture seriously, listening carefully and obeying what it says.

B. Scripture didn't originate from the prophet's personal thoughts and opinions.

 The writers were guided, directed, and "carried along" (like a ship moved by the wind) by the Holy Spirit.

4. Read John 12:47-48

A. Those who reject God's Word will be judged by God's Word.

- We must take God's Word seriously.
- What we do with God's Word now will determine our standing before Him later.

5. Read Hebrews 4:12

A. God's Word is alive and powerful.

• The Word of God is not just ink on paper—it is living and active, still speaking and working today.

B. God's Word cuts deep.

• It penetrates into the deepest parts of our thoughts, motives, and hearts.

C. God's Word discerns the truth about us.

• It exposes what is truly inside us—our real intentions, attitudes, and desires.

6. Read Luke 8:15

A. A noble and good heart:

- Hears: It listens to God's Word with sincerity and a desire to obey.
- **Holds fast:** It clings firmly to God's truth, refusing to let it be stolen by life's difficulties and distractions.
- Bears fruit: It endures trials as it spiritually matures into the likeness of Christ.

7. Read Mark 7:5-8

A. Man-made teachings lead to vain (useless) worship.

• Worship becomes empty when based on human rules rather than God's Word.

8. Read Acts 17:10-11

A. Examine everything you hear by God's Word.

- The Bereans were commended because they didn't blindly accept what they heard.
- They tested every message by comparing it to the Scriptures.

9. Read Psalm 119:11

A. We should make it our goal to store God's Word in our hearts.

- Storing up the Word means keeping it close through memorization, meditation, and daily reflection.
- God's Word strengthens us to resist temptation and make righteous choices.
